From the desk of our Chaplain

Since May of 2011 will forever mark the Beatification of Pope John Paul II, let me simply share with you some of the statistics so accurately describing this extraordinary Pope:

1 billion is the estimated number of people who saw Pope John Paul II in person during his pontificate. 17 million is the estimated number of people whom Pope John Paul II has addressed in his weekly general audiences in St. Peter's Square. 765,000 is the approximate number of miles Pope John Paul traveled since his election on Oct. 16, 1978. 375,000 is the **n**umber of people who gathered for a papal Mass in Denver's Cherry Creek State Park for World Youth Day on Aug. 15, 1993. 1,345 is the number of holy men and women beatified by Pope John Paul II. 483 is the number of saints he has canonized during his pontificate. This is more than all the popes of the past 500 years combined; his 17 immediate predecessors had named only 302. 133 is the number of countries around the world Pope John Paul II visited as Pope and 104 is the number of papal trips he took outside Italy. 26 is the number of years — along with five months and 17 days — Pope John Paul II occupied the Chair of St. Peter, from Oct. 16, 1978, to April 2, 2005 and 3rd position is where Pope John Paul II ranks among longest-serving pontiffs, behind Blessed Pope Pius IX (31 years, seven months, 21 days) and Peter (dates uncertain). 0 is the number of non-Italian popes from the time of Pope Adrian VI (1522-23) to the election of Pope John Paul II in 1978. Vivat Jesus!
